# Pemiscot County: Interstate 55/Route 84 Interchange at Hayti

## What kind of improvements will be made?

The pavement will be replaced on the Interstate 55 northbound on ramp, the I-55 southbound off ramp and on either side of the Route 84 overpass bridge. Additionally, the signals and overhead signs will be replaced.

# What kind of impacts will that have on traffic?

The contractor should be able to perform work on the ramps with minimal impacts to normal traffic flow. However, work along Route 84 will have more significant impacts to traffic. To minimize the impacts to Route 84 travelers, the contractor will be required to work overnight from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The contract will also include the option for the contractor to close the ramps at the intersection of Route 84 for a maximum of four days.

When new pavement is placed, turning movements will be restricted in some areas. The contractor will be directed to minimize the duration of these restrictions.

#### When is this going to happen?

MoDOT plans to accept bids for the project in December 2010. If the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission awards the project at the January 2011 meeting, the work would start in the spring 2011.

## How long is this going to take?

The project is expected to be completed by the end of the summer 2011.
