Sealed bids for Public Improvements for, Mill and Overlay for Jackson Street, will be received at: Willard, City Hall, 224 W Jackson Street, Willard, Missouri, 65781 until 11:00 A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 20th day of August 2024, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to the City of Willard, 224 W Jackson Street, Willard, Missouri and designated as bid for MILL & OVERLAY FOR JACKSON STREET.

The proposed work includes: The milling and overlaying of Jackson Street, minor ADA improvements along the project, and all other miscellaneous work required for completion of the project.

PLEASE NOTE: Official plan holders list will only be the list maintained by Springfield Blue Print. All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Willard hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2024 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within thirty (30) calendar days of beginning work on the construction project. No matter what date the contractor chooses to begin the project, the project must be completed on or before November 15, 2024.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder

The City of Willard reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 6 % .

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
