

School Bus Stop Ahead Sign Confirmation Process



Description

The school bus stop ahead sign confirmation process is used to determine which of these signs are still necessary to maintain and which ones are no longer necessary and can be removed.

Benefit

These sign locations continuously change due to families moving and children growing. Without using this process, unnecessary signs may be maintained and replaced, wasting valuable resources. It can also become a hazard to the public when it warns them of a condition that doesn't exist. In this confirmation process, schools are contacted every summer and given a map with sign locations. When they confirm which signs are/needed, we remove them or maintain them as necessary.
