Legislatively Designated and Funded Initiatives House Bills 4, 19 and 20

This section of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program contains projects funded by Missouri's General Assembly during the 2023 legislative session in HB4, HB19 and HB20 for Multimodal Operations Projects and Programs. All projects in this section are subject to the Governor's approval.

All other modes of transportation (aviation, rail, waterways, freight, and transit) received general revenues to focus on safety, capital improvements and/or operating assistance in these various projects and programs within Multimodal Operations.
