<u>2nd Quarter Update-</u> Ms. Keeven reviewed the 2nd quarter report with the Board. She reported the Copay Assistance program has saved the Plan \$961,428 year to date for 2019. The Plan currently has 132 members utilizing drugs on Copay assistance with a total drug count of 50.
