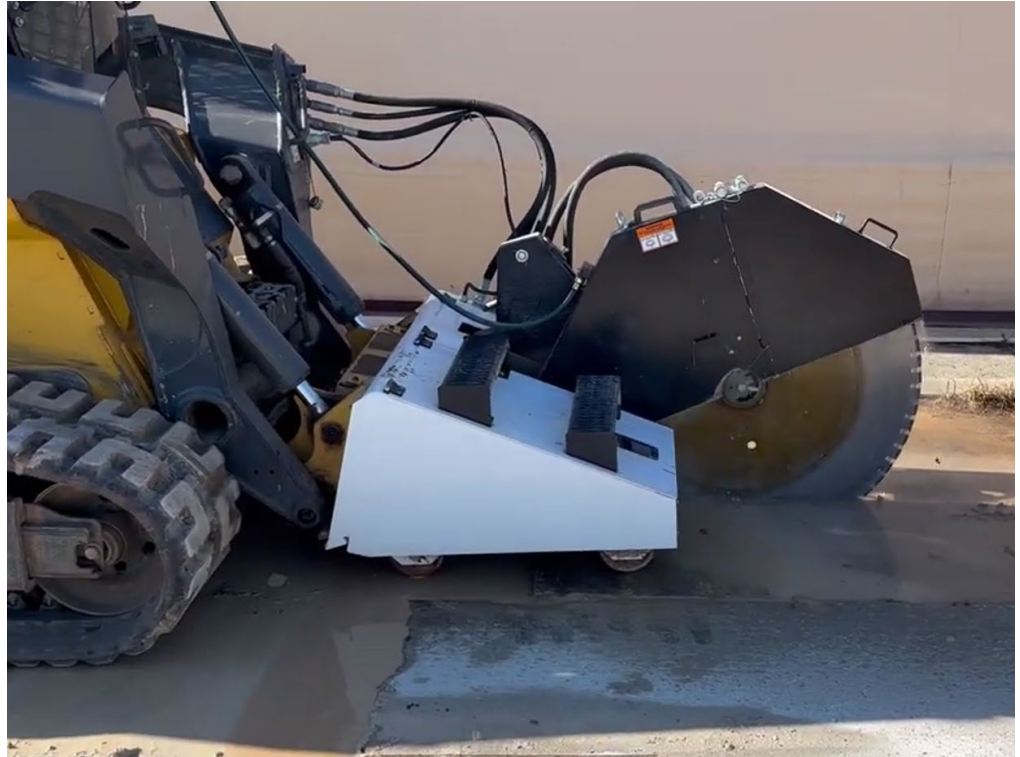

Skid Steer Mounted Concrete Saw



Description and Benefit

The Skid Steer-Mounted Concrete Saw is an innovation that significantly improves safety and efficiency by replacing heavy, awkward walk-behind saws. Previously, crews had to haul the walk-behind saw on a trailer and manually maneuver it on the job, often requiring operators to stand on the centerline with their back to traffic—a dangerous and physically demanding position. The new design mounts the saw on the front of a skid steer, placing the operator inside an enclosed, protected cab with built-in safety features. This eliminates manual handling, reduces strain on the operator's back and legs, and improves hearing protection. It also makes cutting near the centerline much safer and easier, while saving time and reducing injury risks.
