



ANSWER THE CALL!

MODOT IS HIRING EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL FOR THE 2023-24 WINTER SEASON

Our emergency maintenance operators are on hand to answer the call when winter weather and other emergencies threaten our state's highways.

Right now, there are several emergency maintenance equipment operator positions open for qualified drivers to handle winter/emergency maintenance operations across the Show-Me State.

Salaries during emergency operations start at a minimum of \$22.08 an hour and depend on level of experience and area of operation. During normal winter operations, salaries will start at a minimum of \$19.08 an hour. Hourly rates are dependent on the area of operation and experience. An additional \$1 per hour for night work (7 p.m. – 7 a.m.). This is an on-call position – hours will vary depending on weather events.

If you're a service-oriented individual who is at least 18 years old and can successfully complete a criminal background check (a misdemeanor or felony conviction is not an automatic bar to employment) and drug screening, MoDOT wants you to consider a career working to keep Missouri moving this winter.
