Description and Benefit

The Sonetics Headset is a wireless communication system with hear-through technology that allows crews to communicate clearly in loud environments while maintaining awareness of surrounding traffic and sounds. It replaces hand signals and shouting, enabling hands-free conversations between team members, such as sign crews working in buckets and ground personnel or striping crews coordinating between lead, follow, and striping trucks. The headset also integrates with truck radios for broader communication and doubles as hearing protection by blocking harmful noise while letting essential sounds through. This innovation saves time by eliminating work interruptions for communication, simplifies tasks with hands-free operation, and greatly improves safety by combining effective communication with hearing protection in noisy work zones.
