IDOT Bridge and MoDOT Riverview Interchange Public Meeting - May 4

Commuters who travel on the Chain of Rocks bridge and/or use the I-270 and Riverview interchange will not want to miss the information public meeting on Wednesday, May 4. The public meeting will be held from 4 to 7 p.m. at the Southwestern Illinois College located at 4950 Maryville Road, Granite City, IL 62040.

During the public meeting, attendees will receive information about the Chain of Rocks bridge replacement construction, as well as, the I-270 and Riverview interchange construction project. IDOT and MoDOT engineers and construction consultants will share information about the project, schedule, and expected impacts to commuters for the projects.

There will be no formal presentation. Attendees can stop by any time between 4 and 7 p.m. on Wednesday, May 4.
