The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) will be hosting a pre-industry meeting for the St. Louis District's upcoming Safety Improvements Design-Build Project. This meeting will be held at MoDOT's St. Louis District Office at 1590 Woodlake Dr. Chesterfield, MO 63017 in Room 160 on March 22, 2023, from 1 pm to 3 pm. There will be a virtual option, however in-person attendance is strongly encouraged

In this meeting, the project team will gauge interest in the project and share their planned approach and procurement methodology. MoDOT will be seeking feedback from the industry on the information presented. MoDOT plans to begin procurement this summer and award in early 2024.

The Safety Improvements Project is being developed to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes in MoDOT's St. Louis District for pedestrians and other roadway users. This project is a partnership between MoDOT and St. Louis County and will involve work on both state and county roads.

The project goals for this project are:

- 1. Reduce fatal and serious injury crashes within the budget of \$49 million.
- 2. Maximize safety improvements for pedestrians and roadway users distributed equitably across the project area.
- 3. Provide improvements with reasonable maintenance and service life.
- 4. Construct improvements with an emphasis on safety for workers and the traveling public.
- 5. Deliver the project by June 30, 2026, using a diverse workforce.
