Sealed bids for Flashing Yellow Arrow Signalization Improvements – Phase II Project; CMAQ – 7302(668), City Project #17STR14,

will be received at: 200 North Second Street, St. Charles, MO.

until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 26 day of April, at the office of the Engineering Office, Rm 202, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of The bid proposal shall be made on a form of proposal, provided in the specifications and delivered in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside **Bid No. 4307** to the Public Works Office on or before the time specified above. No facsimiles will be accepted. The proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check of a bank or trust company in St. Charles County, City of St. Charles, St. Louis County, or in the City of St. Louis for an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the bid amount. The amount of the check shall be forfeited to the City if the bidder neglects or refuses to enter into a contract or to furnish bond after their proposal has been accepted.

The Scope of Work consists of replacing existing traffic signal heads with new flashing yellow arrow traffic signal heads at various locations within the City of St. Charles. Traffic control and other incidental items shall be included as shown in the specifications.

A pre-bid conference will not be held.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of St. Charles hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of St. Charles reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 9%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
