ENGAGEMENT TIMELINE

Public Meeting #1 MARCH 3, 2026

Gather concerns and input about the lived experience of using Route 30 (Gravois) and share data from the “existing conditions analysis,” or how Gravois looks, feels, and functions today.

Public Meeting #2 JUNE 2026

After gathering the concerns from the people who regularly use the corridor, we will share potential options for addressing concerns to see which of those options the community is interested in pursuing for the corridor.

Public Co-Creation Workshop SUMMER 2026

Join your neighbors and Gravois users to envision the Gravois of the future together with an interactive workshop!

Public Meeting #3 NOVEMBER 2026

The third public meeting will share the recommendations that the department has determined for the corridor, checking with the public to see that those recommendations continue to meet the vision for Gravois and that the impacts of those options are acceptable. This meeting will include safety demonstrations along Gravois

Public Meeting #4 SEPTEMBER 2027

The department will share the plans that have been determined, based on the input from the community, for a final check from the people who live, work, play, commute or otherwise travel Gravois. This remains early in the process so that if the plan needs to be adjusted, it can.

RESIDENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

MULTIMODAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

This group will focus more on the technical side of planning a corridor, and all the forms of mobility that people use today and in the future to get around Route 30 (Gravois)

- Apply if you walk, bike, use public transit, and/or use mobility aids (like a walker, wheelchair, canes, or more) to get around Gravois
- People living with disabilities encouraged to apply
- People who live near Gravois prioritized, but frequent Gravois users encouraged to apply
