

Strike Team Tank Skid



Description and Benefit

The Strike Team Tank Skid is an innovation designed to improve safety, save time, and simplify roadside spraying operations. Previously, tall water tanks were strapped directly to truck beds, causing damage over time, creating handling issues when filled, and requiring personnel to climb onto trucks to secure straps—posing fall hazards. The new design uses low-profile tanks mounted on a skid that can be easily installed or removed with a loader or forklift and secured with four bolts. All tanks and hoses are integrated into one assembly, allowing quick seasonal installation and removal, reducing labor and simplifying storage since everything remains intact for the next season. This strap-free system keeps personnel on the ground, eliminating climbing risks and improving safety. The innovation also enhances efficiency by reducing setup time and minimizing handling challenges, while offering a cost-effective solution that can be built by two people in just a few days for about \$1,000. Overall, the Strike Team Tank Skid modernizes transport for spraying operations, delivering a safer, faster, and more streamlined process.
