Description and Benefit

MoDOT hosted its first statewide Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSMO) Summit on October 7–8, bringing employees together to learn, collaborate, and share strategies for safer, more efficient travel. TSMO focuses on optimizing system performance through cost-effective solutions—such as smart work zones, dynamic messaging boards, cameras, and data analytics—rather than expanding roadways. The summit emphasized cross-discipline collaboration, introduced new tools, and highlighted real-world success stories, fostering a culture shift toward low-cost, high-impact strategies. By creating TSMO champions in every district and promoting shared responsibility across all divisions, MoDOT aims to reduce congestion, improve safety, and deliver better service statewide.
