Indemnification: To the extent allowed by law, the Volunteer assumes the obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the Commission, including its officers, employees and agents, from every expense, liability or payment arising from any claim, lawsuit or liability which may arise from the Volunteer's participation in the program.

Eligibility: Individuals, as Volunteers or as members of Volunteer organizations and enterprises, will not be approved to participate in the program if they have been convicted of, or pled guilty or no contest to, a violent criminal activity, unless 10 years have passed since completion of the latest incarceration, probation or parole for violent criminal activity.

4. Administrative Rules: The Volunteer shall comply with the administrative rules of the Missouri Department of Transportation, under Title 7, Chapter 14, including any rules promulgated or amended after the date of this Agreement.

Please call approximately a week in advance of your scheduled clean-up to make an appointment to pick-up your supplies. All supplies must be picked up by appointment, as crews are often working away from their work building.

After you have completed your litter pick-up, please report the number and approximate location of your bags to swcr@modot.mo.gov, and we will arrange for our crews to pick them up at their next available opportunity.

Any borrowed supplies such as vests or safety flags should be returned after the pickup is completed. These can be returned to the same location that supplies were collected. Due to the cost of vests and safety flags, we must clean and reuse these with our one-off litter pick-up groups.
