- Support southwest Missouri public school clubs to clean 33 miles of right of way in their cities and counties four times each school year
- Educate students on the litter issue
- Build better citizens for tomorrow through participation/education

Litter Pick-UP Dates

- Litter Pick-Up Dates* for the 2023-24 School Year:
 - September 10-16
 - February 11-17
 - November 5-11
 - May 5-11

(*Dates scheduled to change)



Funding & Compensation

- MoDOT to pay schools per pick up cycle
- Compensation amount:
 - \$150 per event
 - Total of \$600 per group
 - \$100 Bonus if the 4 scheduled litter pick-ups are completed
- Payments issued to schools. Each school is responsible to disperse funds to the participating clubs.
- Funding must be used by the participating organization

School Requirements

- Must be an established, school-approved organization with a sponsor present at the time of "litter pick-up"
- Participant/group must sign a "Team Up to Clean Up" agreement
- 1 adult supervisor for every 8 participants
- Participants in grades 9th-12th
- Groups of 20+ may choose multiple ½ mile sections and be compensated. Must be established prior to participation. Groups of 20 or less count as 1 group.
- Pick 1 mile of roadway (1/2 mile on each side), within the district boundaries
- Students to pick up trash during the four yearly designated time frames
- Report each group's number of bags, number of participants, locations and date of pick on the online form
- Participants are required to watch the MoDOT safety video
- Participants must wear safety vests and use trash pickers or gloves
- Safety vests provided by MoDOT
- Pick-up locations are in city limits, on low-speed routes, preferably with sidewalks, curbs, and gutter
