Project Facts

- Four lanes and shoulders for Ten miles along U.S. Route 61 From Route M to U.S. Route 67
- New Guardrail Installation and Existing Guardrail replacement
- Gutter and ADA Sidewalk Improvements
- 3 Box Culvert Replacements over:
 - o Brauhn Creek
 - o Branch of Brauhn Creek
 - o Gibson Creek
 - o Various Signal Replacements

Traffic Impacts

- Temporary moving lane closures along Route
 61 during paving operation
- Temporary Entrance and shoulder closures along project length during construction
- One-way alternating direction lane operation during construction of Concrete Box Culverts

Construction

- Public Meeting: Fall 2025
- Right of Way Acquisitions: Winter 2025
- Project Awarded: Spring 2026
- Construction Start: Spring 2026
- Construction Completion: Summer 2028
- Project Cost: \$7.8 million
