Description and Benefit

This medical kit is designed to be accompanied with a brush/tree cutting crew, where the risks of lifethreatening injuries due to chain saws are elevated. The kit provides tools available to reduce traumatic bleeding and injury. Our Trauma Kit provides essential first-aid tools to reduce and stop bleeding associated with traumatic injuries to control arterial bleeding, hemorrhaging or drawing chest wounds. Arterial bleeding is the highest risk associated with operation of a chain saw and chippers which can lead to unconsciousness in 20 seconds if not stopped. This trauma kit has lifesaving possibilities and is packaged in a durable, waterproof pelican hard case for job site durability.
