Its compact size and 17-foot turning radius allow quick, safe turnarounds without using driveways, reducing backing accidents and keeping work zones shorter for better radio communication and traffic management. Equipped with 360° visibility, mirrors, LED lights, a horn for worker alerts, and a “Stay Back 100 Feet” sign, it improves crew and public safety. Onboard storage accommodates tools, equipment, water, and first aid supplies, simplifying daily operations. Additionally, three-person traffic control rotation reduces fatigue and increases overall safety. Versatile in function, the UTV can serve as a pilot vehicle, spray rig, or litter pickup unit, making it a cost-effective, multi-purpose solution that streamlines work zone operations while prioritizing safety.
