

**BID ADVERTISEMENT**  
**Road Work**  
**Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for West Springfield Avenue STP-6200(609), will be received at: City Hall located at 500 East Locust, Union, MO 63084 until 10:00 A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the fourteenth day of December, at the office of the City of Union, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of paper bids.

The proposed work includes: milling and overlaying asphalt pavement and shoulders from Independence Drive to Oak Street, adding 2500 linear feet of sidewalk on the north side of the road, and widening one block of Springfield Avenue from South Mulberry Avenue to Oak Street. Additional improvements include a retaining wall and curb ramp replacements.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Union hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

The prime contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date in order for MoDOT to concur with the award of this project (see section 136.10 of the LPA manual for more details).

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Union reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 13% for the BASE BID ONLY.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
