It is recommended that any public involvement activities be delayed during this time if the delay does not impact the critical path for delivering the project. However, if delaying is not an option, to reduce personal contact as outlined by Center for Disease Control and Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services guidelines, MoDOT will conduct all public meetings virtually until further notice. Determination of when to conduct public involvement (public meetings, public hearings or other informational meeting) will continue to follow <u>EPG 129</u> guidance. For virtual public meetings, the project manager should coordinate with district communications staff to setup a virtual public meeting webpage on the district website. Project information should be made available for public comment on the webpage. In addition, the public meeting notice must include a project contact for coordinating an opportunity to view a hard copy of project information and provide comments at a publicly accessible location. The district will have to provide a time and place to share project documents as needed with interested citizens at their district office or other public location that can follow the COVID-19 screening requirements. All efforts for public involvement and accommodation need to be documented.
