**Road Work Project**

**Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for Aven Road Roadway Improvements on MoDOT Right-of-Way U.S. Highway 160 (MoDOT Job Number J8S3203), will be received at: 731 W. Mt. Vernon, Nixa, Missouri 65714 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 16th day of April, at the office of the office of the engineer, Shaffer & Hines, Inc., and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work includes: Providing a right-in / right-out roadway access onto U.S. Highway 160. The project will include pavement removal, asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, low profile concrete median island, grading, 24" RCP culvert, temporary traffic control, permanent traffic signs, pavement marking, and erosion control.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from the office of the engineer at 731 W. Mt. Vernon, Nixa, Missouri 65714 for a non-refundable deposit of \$25.00.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Missouri Department of Labor Standards.

The Wasson Family Limited Partnership Agreement hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The Wasson Family Limited Partnership Agreement reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 0%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
