## Job Nos. J4I3005 \& J4I3023

$\square$ Job No. J4I3023: I-35 improvements from Vivion Road to the l-435 interchange, including the complete replacement of the l-35 twin bridges over Poe Street.
$\square$ Job No. J4I3005: I-35, US 69, Pleasant Valley Road, and South Liberty Parkway improvements from the l-435 interchange to just south of the Flintlock overpass.

## J4I3023 Details

$\square$ There are no utility impacts on this project (JSP F)
$\square$ Sound wall designs and foundation placements will need to take into account isolated perpendicular utility crossings

- Three sound walls will be constructed on this project
$\square$ Liquidated damages for the Poe Street twin bridge replacements
- JSP D - Liquidated damages in the amount of $\$ 9,800$ per day if traffic is not in the existing or ultimate lane configuration from November $15^{\text {th }}$ to March $15^{\text {th }}$
- JSP E - Liquidated damages in the amount of $\$ 1,800$ per day if Poe Street in closed beyond 150 calendar days
$\square$ Completion date of December 1, 2015

## Auxiliary Lane Topics

$\square$ Auxiliary lane construction

- Begins with a full depth sawcut 1' in from the existing mainline edge of pavement
- Consists of a minimum 6' widening of 9" concrete pavement that will also be covered with SuperPave asphalt
- The remaining 6' shoulder area may also consist of full depth pavement if it will handle temporary traffic phasing
$\square$ Final profile and roadway grades will be controlled by the 3 " asphalt overlay of the existing concrete median pavement


## Auxiliary Lane JSPs

$\square$ JSP O - Adjusting Basin or Inlet
$\square$ JSP R - Coldmilling Existing Rumble Strip
$\square$ JSP AC - Contractor Pavement Widening and Resurfacing Plan

- Along normal crown sections of roadway, the 9' crown shift towards the median creates variable lift thicknesses towards the outer existing lanes
$\square$ Concrete auxiliary lane widening may require a temporary cap of BP-1 in order to maintain bridge traffic phasing prior to the final resurfacing


## J4I3005 Details

$\square$ Notice to Proceed date of September 8, 2014

- Completion date of September 1, 2016
$\square$ JSP G - Lists significant utility coordination that the contractor must expect
- Time Warner Cable is expected to complete their relocation work in July
- Laclede Gas (MGE), Clay County PWSD No. 2, CenturyLink, AT\&T are all expected to complete their relocation work during the month of October
$\square$ JSP III - Delayed Possession
$\square$ No utility relocation work is dependent on the acquisition of new right of way

## J4I3005 Liquidated Damages

$\square$ JSP D - At Shoal Creek, liquidated damages in the amount of $\$ 9,800$ per day if traffic is not in the existing or ultimate lane configuration from November $15^{\text {th }}$ to March $15^{\text {th }}$
$\square$ JSP E - \$9,800 per day liquidated damages for two temporary ramp access detours

- 90 calendar days for the Stewart Road ramp detour
- 90 calendar days for the southbound offramp detour and North Church Road closure
- JSP F - Liquidated damages for the temporary South Outer Road detour (South Church Road)
- Liquidated damages in the amount of $\$ 7,500$ per day for each day beyond 45 calendar days that traffic routed to South Brookside Road
- Scheduling of this detour is dependent on the delayed possession of right of way, so the new Sobbie Road connection can be constructed

$\square$ JSP R - Contractor Pavement Widening and Resurfacing Plan
$\square$ JSP S - Optional Pavements
$\square$ JSP T - Alternates for Pavements
$\square$ JSP AA - Concrete Traffic Barrier, Type C (Modified)
$\square$ JSP CC - Optional Temporary Pavement Marking

- JSP GG - Sound Wall Systems
- One sound wall system on this project (two wall structures)
