



A synopsis of the January 31, 2012 Missouri Transportation Finance Corporation (MTFC) Meeting

## **Summary of Program Activity**

- □ Five loans were approved for \$18,731,448.
- □ As of January 31, 2012, MTFC has approximately \$2.9 million available to loan.

## **Loans Approved**

City of Poplar Bluff - \$8,929,525 to improve the interchange at Route 67 and Oak Grove Road and the intersection at Business Route 67 and Oak Grove Road.

Highway 71/291 Partners In Progress Transportation Development District - \$6,505,904 to improve the interchange at Route 71 and Route 291.

City of Republic - \$221,019 to improve the intersection of Route 60 and Oakwood Avenue.

City of O'Fallon - \$1,320,000 to construct Crusher Street extension.

City of O'Fallon - \$1,755,000 to improve Elaine Drive.

## **Looking Ahead**

The MTFC's next meeting is scheduled for May 1, 2012. The deadline to apply is March 15, 2012.
