Regarding Friday's 10am bid, "SL14-030-RW Bridge Epoxy Overlay McDonnell, St. Louis County" I have a question to ask the engineer regarding the pavement markings.

Question: Can the replacement striping be Acrylic Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint or must it be Preformed Marking Tape (Grooved)? Note: the existing left arrows and 24" white stop bars are Type II Preformed Marking Tape (Grooved).

MoDOT Response:

An approved Acrylic Waterborne Pavement Marking Paint that is applied according to MoDOT Standards is acceptable. We do not wish to apply any delineation/striping that requires grinding for "insetting" that will damage the epoxy overlay.
