**Questions:** I have a question regarding the definition of brush in the rfq. Is brush defined as the downed limbs and debris or are the Honeysuckle and various volunteers considered to be brush? This will have a huge impact on the pricing? If the Honeysuckle is to be removed do you want the stumps ground out as well or would you prefer herbicide applications?

**Modot Response:** For the purposes of this RFQ, "Brush" is defined as downed limbs and debris as a result of damage, any dead vegetation should be removed, all other live vegetation should be left as is.
