**Contractor Comment:**

I have included an attachment that shows the plastic casting in the hole. If that casting is damaged you cannot replace the casting in the same hole you would need to cut a brand new hole for the new casting to be placed in. The epoxy glue used to install the plastic casting is too durable and will not break cleanly. In theory you should only be replacing the lens like a typical lens replacement project.

**MoDOT Response:**

**Agreed;** If the casting is damaged, and new hole will need to be made for the casting to set into. We will allow the new hole to be in the existing groove, even it is not evenly spaced at 3' intervals as called for in the plans.
