

Response 2: MoDOT requires an unlimited usage plan.

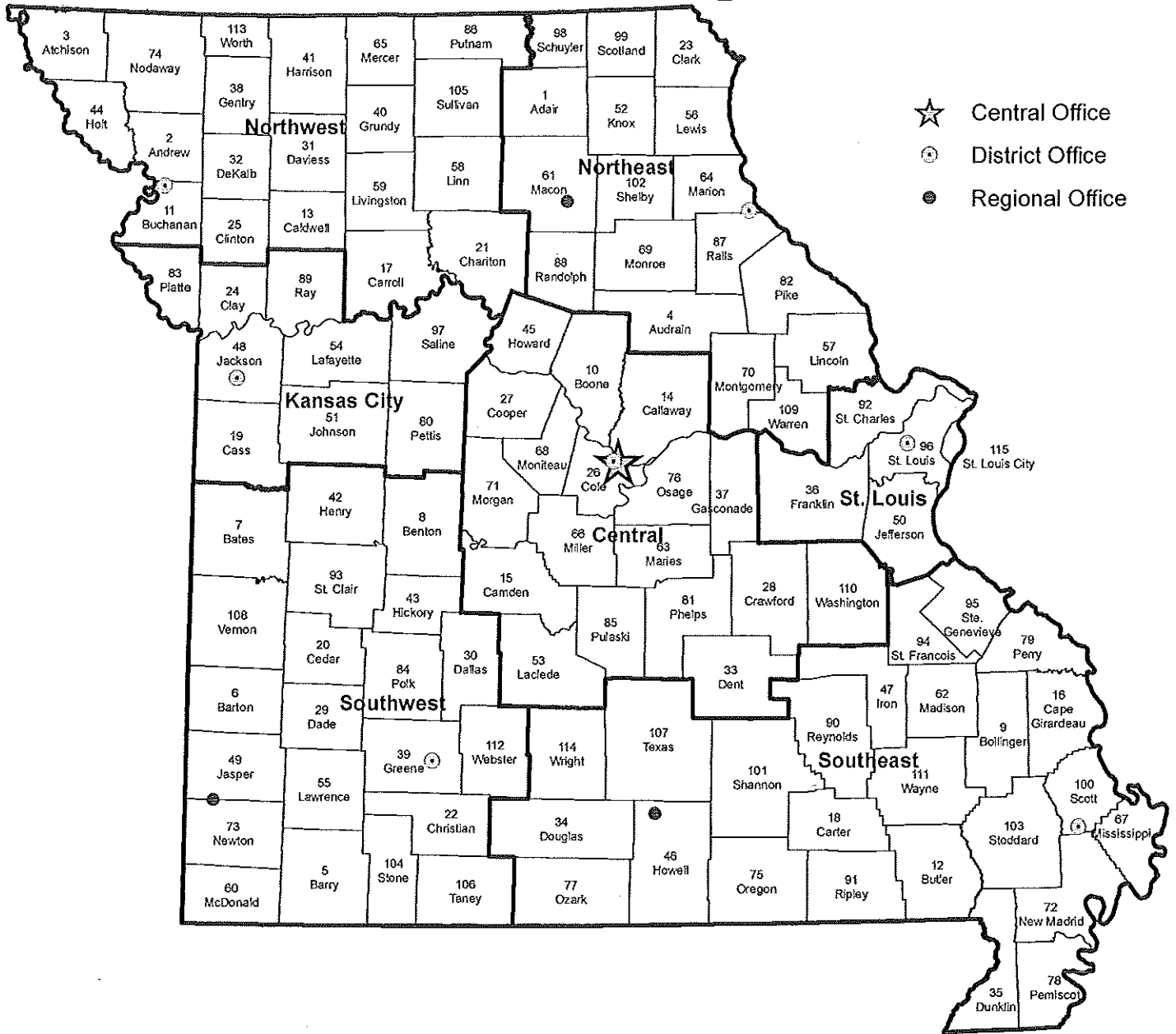
Question 3: Did you have a pre-conference meeting before releasing this RFP?
