#### Question #1

What is the approximate number of participants that will be participating at each location?

#### Response:

10-30 employees at most locations, maximum class size will be determined by bidder based on requirements of training authority.

Will there be a minimum number of participants at each location to hold a class?

**Response:**

Bidder must specify if there is a minimum number to hold class.

**Question #3**

What is the approximate number of participants that will be participating company wide?

**Response:**

Approximately 5,100 potential participants.

**Question #4**

What brand AEDs are currently utilized throughout MoDOT? (We want to ensure we have the appropriate AED trainers so that each participant is comfortable using the Defibrillator in an emergency.

**Response:**

The most common brand would be Zoll, may be a few other brands also.

**Question #5**

On the pricing pages it states "Fixed Rate for First Aid, CPR and AED train the trainer training. Can you go into further detail on this subject?

**Response:**

We currently train most employees in house with MoDOT trainers, some locations may continue with their current program. Periodically there may be a need for new trainers at these locations.

**Question #6**

On the pricing pages it is asking for the fixed rate for CPR, AED & First Aid train the trainer training. I am confused on that because the front service page says it is for regular CPR/AED & First Aid training certifications.

**Response:**

On the pricing page, we are asking for a per student rate for First Aid, CPR and AED Training for the identified locations. In addition to that training, we are asking the cost per student for a separate training for train the trainers if a district wishes to train staff to be trainers.
