Question:

Will the final decision be made on the Evaluation Criterion Points, Price, or the amount of money that will be generating back to the state?

Response:

A total of 40 points are available for scoring of pricing/revenue. Higher revenue to the MHTC will result in a higher number of points during scoring. The remainder of the points are described below.

4.1.1. Evaluation Criteria: Any agreement for services Resulting from this RFP shall be awarded to the Offeror providing the best proposal to MHTC. After determining responsiveness, proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the following criteria and maximum points per each criterion:

Experience, Expertise, and Reliability including Financial Stability of Firm	20 Pts
Qualification and Expertise of Key Personnel	10 Pts
Proposed Method of Performance (Safety of Traveling Public and Roadway Workers, Scalability, Non-Monetary Benefits and Impacts to MHTC Assets)	25 Pts
Proposed Revenue	40 Pts
Overall Clarity and Quality of Proposal.	5 Pts
