### 1.1 Introduction:

### 1.2 General Information:

- 1.2.1 This document constitutes an invitation for competitive, sealed bids for the procurement of track mounted drills as set forth herein.
- 1.2.2 Organization: This RFB is divided into the following parts:

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

### 2.1 General Requirements:

- 2.1.1 The contractor shall provide track mounted drills on an as needed, if needed basis for the MHTC and MoDOT, in accordance with the provisions and requirements stated herein.
- 2.1.2 The contractor shall provide all deliverables/services to the sole satisfaction of MoDOT.
- 2.1.3 MoDOT does not guarantee how many units will be ordered.
- 2.1.4 Unless otherwise specified herein, the contractor shall furnish all material, labor, facilities, equipment, and supplies necessary to provide the deliverables/services required herein.
- 2.1.5 MoDOT reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to accept or reject any items thereon, and to waive technicalities. In case of error in the extension of prices in the bid, unit prices will govern.

### 2.2 Specific Requirements:

2.2.1 The contractor shall provide MoDOT with track mounted drills, in accordance with the attached specifications.

### 2.3 Required Specifications:

a. All materials, equipment, and/or services bid upon must comply with the attached MoDOT specification and any other provisions outlined in the solicitation documents.

### 2.4 Delivery Requirements:

- 2.4.1 The following delivery requirements shall apply:
  - a. Unless otherwise specified on the solicitation documents or purchase order, suppliers shall give at least 24 hours advance notice of each delivery. Delivery will only be received between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Material arriving after 3:00 p.m. will not be unloaded until the following workday. No material will be received on Saturday, Sunday or state holidays.
  - b. If the prices bid herein include the delivery cost of the material, the Contractor agrees to pay all transportation charges on the material as FOB Destination. Freight costs must be included in the unit price bid and not listed as a separate line item.
  - c. Any demurrage is to be paid by the Contractor direct to the railroad or carrier.

### 2.5 Contract/Purchase Order:

2.5.1 The contract expresses the complete agreement of the parties and performance shall be governed solely by the specifications and requirements contained therein. Any change, whether by modification and/or supplementation, must be accomplished by a formal contract amendment signed and approved by and between the duly authorized representative of the Contractor and the duly authorized representative of the MHTC, by a modified purchase order prior to the effective date of such modification. The Contractor expressly and explicitly understands and agrees that no other method and/or no other document, including correspondence, acts, and oral communications by or from any person, shall be used or construed as an amendment or modification.

### 2.6 Invoicing and Payment Requirements:

2.6.1 The contractor shall submit an itemized invoice to the applicable requesting address for the completion of deliverables, as specified herein.

- 2.6.2 Each invoice should be itemized in accordance with items listed on the purchase order and/or contract. The statewide financial management system has been designed to capture certain receipt and payment information. Therefore, each invoice submitted must reference the purchase order number and must be itemized in accordance with items listed on the purchase order. Failure to comply with this requirement may delay processing of invoices for payment.
- 2.6.3 The contractor shall understand and agree MoDOT reserves the right to make contract payments to the contractor through electronic funds transfer (EFT). Therefore, prior to any payments becoming due under the contract, the contractor must return a completed state Vendor Input ACH/EFT Application, which is downloadable from the Vendor Services Portal at: <a href="https://www.vendorservices.mo.gov/vendorservices/Portal/Default.aspx">https://www.vendorservices.mo.gov/vendorservices/Portal/Default.aspx</a>. Each contractor invoice must be on the contractor's original descriptive business invoice form and must contain a unique invoice number. The invoice number will be listed on the state's Vendor Payment Website to enable the contractor to properly apply state payments to invoices. The contractor must comply with all other invoicing requirements stated in the RFB.
- 2.6.4 The contractor shall be paid in accordance with the firm, fixed prices stated on the pricing page of this document after completion of deliverables specified herein and acceptance by MoDOT.
- 2.6.5 Other than the payment specified above, no other payments or reimbursements shall be made to the contractor for any reason whatsoever.
- 2.6.6 Unless otherwise provided for in the solicitation documents, payment for all equipment, supplies, and/or services required herein shall be made in arrears. The MHTC shall not make any advance deposits.
- 2.6.7 The MHTC assumes no obligation for equipment, supplies, and/or services shipped or provided in excess of the quantity ordered. Any authorized quantity is subject to the MHTC's rejection and shall be returned at the contractor's expense.

### 2.7 Other Contractual Requirements:

- 2.7.1 <u>Contract Period</u> The contract shall commence from the date of award until November 30, 2013 with up to two (2) one-year renewal option periods, or any portion therein.
- 2.7.2 <u>Renewal Periods</u> If the option for renewal is exercised by MoDOT, the contractor shall agree to all terms and conditions of the RFB and all subsequent amendments. Renewal options are at the sole discretion of MoDOT.

- 2.7.3 Escalation Clause In the event the contractor requests a price increase during the contract period, either the original contract period or any contract renewal period, the contractor must provide a written request and documentation justifying the need for a price increase, and the amount of such price increase. MoDOT will review the contractor's written request and documentation, and decide if a price increase is to be granted at that particular time. The contractor shall understand and agree that MoDOT's decision shall be final and without recourse.
  - a. No price increase shall be granted during the first 3 months of the original contract period, or if applicable, first 3 months of a contract renewal period.
- 2.7.4 <u>Inspection and Acceptance</u>: MoDOT reserves the right to inspect the equipment at the point of manufacture, intermediate storage point, or at a destination which shall be at the discretion of MoDOT.
  - a. No equipment, supplies, and/or services received by MoDOT pursuant to a contract shall be deemed accepted until MoDOT has had reasonable opportunity to inspect said equipment, supplies, and/or services.
  - b. All equipment, supplies, and/or services which do not comply with the specifications and/or requirements or which are otherwise unacceptable or defective may be rejected. In addition, all equipment, supplies, and/or services which are discovered to be defective or which do not conform to any warranty of the Contractor upon inspection (or at any later time if the defects contained were not reasonably ascertainable upon the initial inspection) may be rejected.
  - c. The MHTC reserves the right to return any such rejected shipment at the Contractor's expense for full credit or replacement and to specify a reasonable date by which replacements must be received.
  - d. The MHTC's right to reject any unacceptable equipment, supplies, and/or services shall not exclude any other legal, equitable or contractual remedies the MHTC may have.

#### 2.8 Additional Notifications:

2.8.1 Bidders are encouraged to obtain minority business enterprise (MBE) and women business enterprise (WBE) participation in this work through the use of subcontractors, suppliers, joint ventures, or other arrangements that afford meaningful participation for M/WBEs. Bidders are encouraged to obtain 10% MBE and 5% WBE participation.

### 2.8.2 Equipment Trade-In Allowance:

- a. If equipment trade-ins are offered as an option, the trade-in(s) must be negotiated between the District, Division and vendor.
- b. The vendor must be currently under contract with MoDOT.
- c. It will be the responsibility of the vendor to examine the condition of the equipment offered for trade. The vendor must not impose any mandatory requirements or restrictions on equipment disposal.
- d. If the value offered is less than the Division's pre-established minimum price, the Division and District must both approve the trade in value.
- e. Allowance for trade-in(s) will be deducted from the full purchase price in computing the net purchase price. Trade-in(s) will not be available until the receipt and acceptance of the new equipment unless agreed upon by the District.

### 2.8.3 Equipment Refurbishments:

- a. If equipment refurbishments are available, the refurbishment(s) must be negotiated between the district and vendor. The vendor must be currently under contract with MoDOT. It will be the responsibility of the vendor to examine the condition of the equipment offered for refurbishment. The districts must keep accurate records verifying the process.

### 3. BID SUBMISSION

### 3.1 Bid Submission Information:

- 3.1.1 All bids must be received in a sealed envelope/packaging clearly marked "3-121120RJ Track Mounted Drills".
- 3.1.2 All bids must be received at the office of the RFB Coordinator as outlined in Section 1. "INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL INFORMATION".
- 3.1.3 The bidder may withdraw, modify or correct his/her bid after it has been deposited with MoDOT provided such request is submitted in writing and received at the location designated for the bid opening prior to the date and time specified for opening bids. Such a request received as specified will be attached to the bid and the bid will be considered to have been modified accordingly. No bid may be modified after the date and time specified for the opening of bids.

### 3.1.4 Open Competition / Request For Bid Document:

- a. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to ask questions, request changes or clarification, or otherwise advise MoDOT if any language, specifications or requirements of an RFB appear to be ambiguous, contradictory, and/or arbitrary, or appear to inadvertently restrict or limit the requirements stated in the RFB to a single source. Any and all communication from bidders regarding specifications, requirements, competitive bid process, etc., must be directed to the buyer from MoDOT, unless the RFB specifically refers the bidder to another contact. Such communication should be received at least three (3) working days prior to the official bid opening date.
- b. Every attempt shall be made to ensure that the bidder receives an adequate and prompt response. However, in order to maintain a fair and equitable bid process, all bidders will be advised, via the issuance of an amendment to the RFB, of any relevant or pertinent information related to the procurement. Therefore, bidders are advised that unless specified elsewhere in the RFB, any questions received less than three (3) working days prior to the RFB opening date may not be answered.
- c. Bidders are cautioned that the only official position of the MoDOT is that which is issued by MoDOT in the RFB or an amendment thereto. No other means of communication, whether oral or written, shall be construed as a formal or official response or statement.
- d. MoDOT monitors all procurement activities to detect any possibility of deliberate restraint of competition, collusion among bidders, price-fixing by bidders, or any other anticompetitive conduct by bidders which appears to violate state and federal antitrust laws. Any suspected violation shall be referred to the Missouri Attorney General's Office for appropriate action.

### 3.1.5 Contract Award:

a. Award of this bid will be made on an "All or Nothing" basis using the "lowest and best" principle of award.

### Item #2 - Training

All specialty equipment and equipment purchased by MoDOT shall have the minimum vendor training supplied as outlined below:

- a. Training shall take place at each district where equipment is delivered or at an off- site location at the vendor's expense. A qualified service technician or mechanic shall conduct the training. Training will be supplied to operators and mechanics of equipment and will cover safe operation and routine/preventative maintenance. The vendor shall supply training within one month of delivery and acceptance. The vendor shall supply all training materials.
- b. Training shall be supplied to MoDOT mechanics by the vendor and will be a minimum 8 hours contact time per module. If more than 8 hours of training is necessary, the districts shall notify the vendor in advance of the scheduled training to setup the additional hours needed. Modules to be covered are electrical, chassis and power train. (also hydraulics if applicable) Warranty coverage(s) will be explained during each of these modules.
- c. Repair manuals shall be supplied in hardcover and CD at a ratio of 3 books and 5 CD's for every five like units. A minimum of 3 hardcover repair manuals will be supplied with any specialty equipment and a CD for each piece.
- d. Operator manuals must be hard copy and supplied with each individual unit.

Should the training not meet the requirements (needs of the employees being trained,) indicated above, the vendor shall come back to the location the training first took place and hold the training again.

Purchases of equipment in quantities of less than five will require the successful vendor to provide at a minimum:

- c. Operator manuals must be hard copy and supplied with each individual unit.
- d. Repair manuals a minimum of 3 hardcover repair manuals will be supplied with any specialty equipment and a CD for each piece.

# Missouri Department Track Mounted Drill Specification

The drill unit shall be an integral part of the track carrier, having a single engine power source. The power shall be appropriately directed to the carrier, hydraulic system, and hydraulically driven drill head. The width of the drill and carrier shall not exceed 94 inches and the travel height shall not exceed 102 inches. The drill shall have been in production for at least two years.

Emergency Shutdown control- Unit shall be equipped with a minimum of two emergency shutdown controls located at the rear of the unit, one accessible on the operator's side and one accessible on the helpers side.

**Power Unit** -The unit shall be powered by a Deutz Model D914L05 air-cooled, diesel, five (5) cylinder, 97, HP @ 2,300 RPM engine. The engine shall include a 12-volt electric start system. The engine shall also include a cold weather-starting package, glow plug type.

**Engine Leveling -** A hydraulically operated engine leveler shall be supplied for use on slopes up to 45 degrees.

**Feed Mechanism** – Shall consist of a double acting chain drive mechanism connected to a hydraulic cylinder with a 13' stroke and capable of 16,000 pounds upward trust and 16,000 pounds pull down. Feed speeds are 0-40 FPM up and down.

**Drill Drive** – Taken from prime mover through a variable volume over center piston pump and tandem fixed volume pump.

Rotary Drive – The drill head shall have at least 8 speeds forward and 8 speeds in reverse. The 4-speed transmission shall be mounted to the drill head and be driven by a hydraulic motor through a 2-speed unit, and actuated electrically from the operator's control panel. The spindle speed shall range from 0-1000RPM. The actual working drill spindle torque shall be 8000 foot-pounds in first gear. The spindle shall be hollow with at least 4-5/8" I.D.

Mast – Welded rectangular structural steel tube construction that supports and guides the rotation of feed components. Rigidly held in the vertical position for drilling with two (2) hydraulic cylinders that also lower the mast to the travel position for moving from hole to hole. Mast extension allows for 20 ft. rod pulls. Mast mounting allows for angle drilling up to 45 degree as well as 90 degree vertical. The in-out slide base has 16" of movement, and the left to right slide has 8" of overall movement; 4" each direction off of center. Also includes mast dump to 60". Includes crown block with sheaves.

Slide Head – Slide movements is 12 inches for allowing access to borehole.



Auger Guide – To accommodate 4-1/4" I.D. hollow stem auger, removable.

**Hydraulic Leveling Jacks** – Must have two (2) front and two (2) rear-mounted jacks, 4" bore X 41" stroke, with counter balance valves.

#### Tracks:

- A. Caterpillar 307D rubber tracts
- B. 18" wide tracks with 2-speed drive.
- C. Speed of the carrier shall be from 0-3.27 MPH.

Sheave Block Assembly - Low clearance with 20 ft. capability of mast extension.

Extruder – To be used with 3"x 36" Shelby Tube Samplers. To have quick release hold down clamp for installing Shelby Tubes and separate hydraulic control located at extruder to provide easy and convenient operation. To include a hinged or removable catch tray. Final mounting location to be approved by MoDOT personnel.

**Main Drum Hoist** - 12,000 lb. planetary type with 75 ft. of 1/2" cable with safety hooks attached.

Wireline Hoist – Hydraulically powered used for wireline core drilling to include 1000 ft, of 3/16" wireline cable. Lifting capacity is 800 lbs with integral hydraulic brake.

Front Winch – Hydraulic powered front mounted winch with 20,000 lb capacity, capable of operating in conjunction with tracks. This unit shall include 100' of 5/8" diameter steel cable with attached safety hooks.

**Auxiliary Winch** – Hydraulic operated with a maximum bare pull of 2,500 pounds. Includes 75 ft. of 3/8 cable with attached safety hooks.

Quick Disconnect Adapter – Shall fit a 1-5/8" hex auger shaft.

Water Pump – Shall be a progressing cavity pump (Moyno 3L6 or equal) with drain plug, mounted to the drill rig, hydraulically driven and including pump speed controls and gauges.

**Auger Rack** – Front mounded auger rack provides storage for up to 50' 4-1/4" hollow stem augers.

140-pound Automatic SPT Hammer- This must be 140 lb. automatic SPT hammer.

**Rod Tray** – Capable of handling 150 feet of NQWL drill rods, 10' foot long. Mounted behind the toolboxes on the helper's side.



**Double Tool Box** –12-3/8" wide x 16" high x 90" long. Must be weatherproof as possible and include a lockable mechanism for the lids.

Hydraulic Breakout Wrench and Rod Clamp - Must be able to handle up to a 5-1/2" O.D. drill rods. Removable from bottom of the mast and used in conjunction with angle holes; includes one (1) set of jaws.

Radio Remote Controller – Functions for the left track, right track, front winch, throttle control, emergency shutdown. A wired controller shall also be furnished as backup. Valve controlling hydraulies needs provision for manual operation.

**Miscellaneous** – Must provide (3) three parts and (3) three operators manuals.

Color- Color to be manufacturer's standard safety or industrial yellow over a prime coat.

The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC), acting by and through its operating arm, the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), draws the Bidder's attention to said 7 CSR 10-11 for all the provisions governing solicitation and receipt of bids/quotes and the award of the contract pursuant to this solicitation.
- All bids/quotes must be signed with the firm name and by a responsible officer or employee. Obligations assumed by such signature must be fulfilled.

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### Definitions

Capitalized terms as well as other terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning assigned to them in section 7 CSR 10-11.010 Definition of Terms.

### **Nondiscrimination**

- a. The Contractor shall comply with all state and federal statutes applicable to the Contractor relating to nondiscrimination, including, but not limited to, Chapter 213, RSMo; Title VI and Title VII of Civil Rights Act of 1964 as amended (42 U.S.C. Sections 2000d and 2000e, et seq.); and with any provision of the "Americans with Disabilities Act" (42 U.S.C. Section 12101, et seq).
- b. Sanctions for Noncompliance: In the event of the Contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination provisions of this contract, MHTC shall impose such contract sanctions as it or the Federal Highway Administration may determine to be appropriate, including, but not limited to:
  - i. withholding of payments to the Contractor under the contract until the Contractor complies, and/or,
  - ii. cancellation, termination or suspension of the contract, in whole or in part.

#### Contract/Purchase Order

- By submitting a bid/quote, the Bidder agrees to furnish any and all equipment, supplies and/or services specified in the solicitation documents, at the
  prices quoted, pursuant to all requirements and specifications contained therein.
- b. A binding contract shall consist of: (1) the solicitation documents, amendments thereto, and/or Best and Final Offer (BAFO) request(s) with any changes/additions, (2) the Contractor's bid response, and (3) the MHTC's acceptance of the bid by post-award contract or purchase order.
- c. A notice of award does not constitute an authorization for shipment of equipment or supplies or a directive to proceed with services. Before providing equipment, supplies and/or services, the Contractor must receive a properly authorized notice to proceed and/or purchase order.

#### Applicable Laws and Regulations

- a. The contract shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Missouri. The Contractor shall comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations related to the performance of the contract. The exclusive venue for any legal proceeding relating to or arising, out of the contract shall be in the Circuit Court of Cole County, Missouri.
- b. The Contractor must be registered and maintain good standing with the Secretary of State of the State of Missouri, Missouri Department of Revenue, and other regulatory agencies, as may be required by law or regulations. Prior to the issuance of a purchase order and/or notice to proceed, the Contractor may be required to submit to MHTC a copy of their current Authority Certificate from the Secretary of State of the State of Missouri and/or a copy of their Certificate of No Tax Due from the Missouri Department of Revenue.
- c. Prior to the issuance of a purchase order and/or notice to proceed, all out-of-state Contractors <u>providing services</u> within the state of Missouri must submit to MHTC a copy of their current Transient Employer Certificate from the Missouri Department of Revenue, in addition to a copy of their current Authority Certificate from the Secretary of State of the State of Missouri.

#### **Executive Order:**

The Contractor shall comply with all the provisions of Executive Order 07-13, issued by the Honorable Matt Blunt, Governor of Missouri, on the sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) day of March, 2007. This Executive Order, which promulgates the State of Missouri's position to not tolerate persons who contract with the state engaging in or supporting illegal activities of employing individuals who are not eligible to work in the United States, is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement.

- 3) The Contractor shall include the provisions of this paragraph in every subcontract. The Contractor shall take such action with respect to any subcontract as the Commission may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions, including sanctions for noncompliance.

### <u>Preferences</u>

- a. In the evaluation of bids/quotes, preferences shall be applied in accordance with 7 CSR 10-11.020(7). Contractors should apply the same preferences in selecting subcontractors. The attached document entitled "VENDOR INFORMATION AND PREFERENCE CERTIFICATION FORM" must be completed and returned with the solicitation documents.
- b. Bidders are encouraged to obtain minority business enterprise (MBE) and women business enterprise (WBE) participation in this work through the use of subcontractors, suppliers, joint ventures, or other arrangements that afford meaningful participation for MWBEs. Bidders are encouraged to obtain 10% MBE and 5% WBE participation.

#### Bankruptcy or Insolvency

Upon filing for any bankruptcy or insolvency proceeding by or against the Contractor, whether voluntarily, or upon the appointment of a receiver, trustee, or assignee, for the benefit of creditors, the Commission reserves the right and sole discretion to either cancel the Agreement or affirm the Agreement and hold the Contractor responsible for damages.

#### Warranty

The Contractor expressly warrants that all equipment, supplies, and/or services provided shall: (1) conform to each and every specification, drawing, sample or other description which was furnished to or adopted by the MHTC, (2) be fit and sufficient for the purpose expressed in the solicitation documents, (3) be merchantable, (4) be of good materials and workmanship, and (5) be free from defect.

#### Status of Independent Contractor

The Contractor represents itself to be an independent Contractor offering such services to the general public and shall not represent itself or its employees to be an employee of the MHTC. Therefore, the Contractor shall assume all legal and financial responsibility for taxes, FICA, employee fringe benefits, workers' compensation, employee insurance, minimum wage requirements, overtime, etc., and agrees to indemnify, save and hold the MHTC, its officers, agents and employees harmless from and against any and all losses (including attorney fees) and damage of any kind related to such matters.

#### Non-Waiver

If one of the parties agrees to waive its right to enforce any term of this Contract, that party does not waive its right to enforce such term at any other time or to enforce any or all other terms of this Contract.

### Indemnification

The Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless MHTC, including its members and department employees, from any claim or liability whether based on a claim for damages to real or personal property or to a person for any matter relating to or arising out of the Contractor's performance of its obligations under the contract awarded pursuant to this solicitation.
