- 1. Are all curbs to be edged with an edger or can a weed eater be used to trim along the curb edge?** As stated in section 2.5.3 Contractor may use riding mower, push, walk behind, and weed eaters or necessary equipment to accomplish mowing.
- 2. Do the grounds have sprinkler systems and if so where are the sprinklers located?** The grounds do have a sprinkler system. The selected contractor will be shown the locations of all sprinklers.
- 3. Is the mowing to be done all the way back to the railroad tracks behind the Outer Office Complex and if not where shall the mowing stop?** The mowing will stop where you can visibly see that recent mowing has occurred. The rest of the area back to the railroad tracks will be mowed when needed by MoDOT employee(s).
- 4. Can a weed spray be used and if so where is it acceptable to spray?** A chemical may be used for weed control as long as the contractor is knowledgeable in using the correct product and all environmental conditions are met by the manufacturer of the product. Weed control must be pleasing to the eye and acceptable to MoDOT.
- 5. Will the trimming and/or pruning of any hedge, bush, or shrub be considered part of this project?** No this is a mowing service bid.
- 6. Why is the mowing required to be done after 4:30 pm weekdays or Saturday and Sunday?** This is to prevent any damage to personal vehicles that will be on the property during the weekday until 4:30 p.m.
