## Specifications Revisions:

- 1. Revise the text in Section 00100, Bidder Requirements, in Hold Points paragraph 12. B. 2. from: "After the concrete pad extensions are installed." to "After pouring new concrete pad."
- 2. Add after item 13 in Section 00100, Bidder Requirements as follows:
  - 14. Boilers for both projects shall be of the same manufacturer.

## Revisions to St. Louis District Office Boiler System Plans AND St. Louis Traffic Management Center Boiler System Plans:

- 1. Add the following notes to Sheet M-1 of both sets of plans:
  - 25. Product substitutes will be the contractor's responsibility to provide equivalent products, submitted and reviewed as normal product submittals.
  - 26. Controls must interface with Modbus or BACnet.
  - 27. Existing backflow preventer is to remain.
  - 28. Match existing hot water piping material with schedule 40 pipe and fittings.
  - 29. Measure existing flow of each pump to be demolished prior to demolition and rebalance to existing gpm flow rate.
