5. REVISED MODOT PREFERRED FEATURES/ITEMS:

The following are additional items/features that MoDOT is interested in purchasing on their units. Place an X next to any of those features/items that you will provide and include in the price of the base unit. The more expensive features/items may instead be bid as Optional items on the PRICING PAGE.

- _____ Passenger seat to be the same as the driver seat.
- _____ Fully adjustable air suspension driver and passenger seats with center foldable armrests on both truck seats.
- _____ Intermittent windshield wipers.
- _____ Two copies of both the paper form and the CD version of the repair and parts manual.
- _____ Greasable pins on the inspection unit.
- _____ Engine kill safety switches mounted at the rear of the deck of the truck.
- _____ Dual power windows and door locks.
- _____ Diesel fuel tank mounted on the driver side.
- _____ Front fender spot convex mirrors attached from fender to side of hood near front of hood as to not have a problem with cracking the fiberglass fender.
- _____ Removable podium that mounts to top rail of bucket on passenger side looking forward for writing in clipboard.
- _____ Cup holders in the cab and in the bucket (Preferably removable).
- _____ Clearance cameras on all booms and 1 mounted on back side of truck to view while backing up to include monitor in cab.
- _____ Axle locks on front axle instead of torsion bar.
- _____ Upgraded sound system with external inputs and Bluetooth capability.
- _____ A foldable small bench seat in the bucket that would allow the occupants to get off their feet for a few minutes, get out of the wind, warm up, etc.
- _____ Tie off loops mounted higher in the bucket to allow more movement.
- _____ Cruise control
- _____ Ability to operate the boom from either side of the bucket and not just in the middle of the bucket.
