Project Description:

The project will involve resurfacing and shoulder improvements on Route B from Route 32 to Coffman, as well as replacing the River Aux Vases Bridge.



Timeline:

The project is expected to be awarded by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission in January 2010. Based on the community input received at the public meeting in May, Route B will be closed February thru May 2010. During this time, the River Aux Vases Bridge will be replaced. Grading work and resurfacing will be completed in fall and summer 2010.
