



The Missouri Department of Transportation is currently planning to improve three bridges located on Route TT in Dunklin County, as well as a bridge located on Route P in Dunklin County.

ROUTE TT

Project Description

The Route TT projects will include replacing the bridges over Sand Slough Ditch, Drainage Ditch No. 8 and Belfontain Ditch. The new bridges will be wider than the existing structures and will feature lower rails to better accommodate agricultural traffic.

Timeline

Work will begin in spring 2016, with completion anticipated in fall 2017. The schedule will allow access to the levee between Belfontain Ditch and Ditch No. 8 during both phases of the project.

Traffic Impacts

A road closure will be in effect for Route TT from Route 164 in Missouri to Route 181 in Arkansas, with accessibility to local traffic only.

ROUTE P

Project Description

The project will include replacing the Route P bridge over Buffalo Ditch with a box culvert designed to better serve agricultural traffic.

Timeline

Work will begin in spring 2016, with completion anticipated in fall 2016. Construction will take place during the summer to avoid impacts to the school as much as possible.

Traffic Impacts

A road closure will be in effect for Route P as construction is underway, with accessibility to local traffic only.
