- (4) Designs and conducts special or experimental investigations of design, materials or construction practices used in highway and bridge construction, maintenance operations or equipment.
- (5) Reviews or prepares specifications and special provisions; reviews construction plans for implementation of recommended special procedures; reviews standards and best practice methods proposed by national organizations.

- (6) Evaluates new products for development and makes recommendations for possible use by the department.
- (7) Performs lead worker responsibilities, which may include providing general instruction, assigning and reviewing work, coaching and training, providing guidance and instruction in the proper and most efficient methods of accomplishing tasks, and providing input to the direct supervisor on staffing decisions and performance management.
- (8) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
