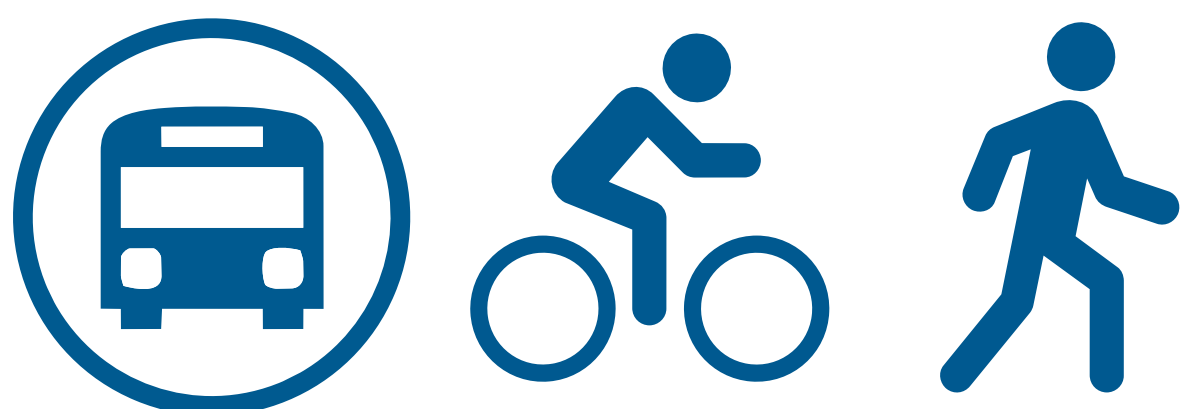
Why the Project is Needed:
