ROUTE U ST. FRANCIS RIVER OVERFLOW

PUBLIC MEETING: JUNE 9, 2016

What are the benefits of this project?

The project includes replacing the deck of the Route U bridge over the St. Francis River Overflow. The improved bridge will be 24-feet wide—two feet wider than the existing structure.

What is the timeline?

The project is expected to be awarded in December 2016. The bridge will close for six to eight weeks as construction is underway, weather permitting.

Additional details regarding the contractor's schedule will be released prior to the start of construction. Arrangements will be made to minimize impacts to agricultural operations as much as possible.

Completion is anticipated in late 2017 or early 2018.

How will this impact my daily commute?

The bridge will close as construction is underway.
