Iron County ROUTE 72 OVER STOUTS CREEK

PUBLIC MEETING: MARCH 21, 2017

What are the benefits of this project?

The project includes replacing the Route 72 bridge over Stouts Creek, just east of Arcadia, Mo. The improved bridge will be 26 feet wide, which is 6 feet wider than the existing bridge.

Where will the new bridge be constructed?

MoDOT is currently considering three alternates.

Alternate A includes constructing the new bridge to the north of the existing structure. Traffic would continue to use the existing bridge during construction.

Alternate B includes constructing the bridge on the existing alignment. The road would need to be closed throughout construction.

Alternate C includes constructing the new bridge to the south of the existing structure. Traffic would continue to use the existing bridge during construction.

What is the timeline?

The project is expected to be under construction throughout summer 2018.

How will this impact my daily commute?

Impacts to traffic will depend on the alternate selected. Constructing the bridge on the existing alignment would result in a road closure, with Routes 67 and 221 serving as the temporary detour.
