St. Louis County is soliciting sealed electronic bids for work as defined below.

The scope of the work will consist of, but is not limited to, replacing underground electric circuit and edge lighting fixtures, installation of new regulator, concrete pavement joint and spall repairs (edge and corner) and cracked panel repairs.

Sealed electronic bids will be opened at the office of the St. Louis County L. K. Roos Building, 41 S. Central Avenue, 8th Floor—Conference Room, Clayton, MO 63105, at **2:00 P.M.**, prevailing Central time, June 5, 2018. Immediately thereafter, they will be publicly opened and read aloud. A DBE contract goal of twelve percent (12%) has been established for this contract. The project is subject to grant funding.

It takes approximately 24 hours to process the registration. Bids will be electronically submitted through MUNIS Vendor Self Service and will be received by Vendor Self Service by 2:00 p.m. prevailing Central Standard Time. **Bidders may not download the electronic bid and submit it in paper form to the Procurement Division.** Bidders must bid electronically for a valid bid. If bidder is unable to respond electronically, the bidder must contact the Procurement Division for an official hardcopy of the solicitation, termed a “walk-in” bid, before the bid opening date and time. The Procurement Division is not responsible for late bids that are submitted on the walk-in form. Receipt of a walk-in bid will be date stamped and recorded in the Procurement Division. Bids that are not submitted electronically or on an official walk-in bid form may be considered unacceptable. Faxed bids **will not** be accepted.

Bid specifications together with Contract Documents, Printed Forms, on which bids must be submitted and other information relating to the project may be obtained from County Blue Online Plan Room at www.countyblue.com. Select On-Line Planroom and select Public Jobs. Any plans, drawings or specification books will be available on or after May 15, 2018. There will be no refunds on any documents purchased.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at Spirit of St. Louis Airport Conference Room on May 22, 2018 at 2:00 PM prevailing central time. Bidders are advised to visit the site, investigate all conditions involved in the execution of the Work.

Contract Time. The Director of Procurement has established a contract performance time of one hundred seventy five (175) calendar days from the date of the Notice-to-Proceed. All project work shall be substantially completed within the stated timeframe. This project is subject to liquidated damages as prescribed on the Bid Form and Document 00775.

Bid Security. No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a bid bond secured by an approved surety or sureties, payable to the Director of Procurement, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid.

Bonding Requirements. The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price within ten (10) days from the date of contract execution.

Award of Contract. All bids submitted in accordance with the instructions presented herein will be subject to evaluation. Bids may be held by the St. Louis County, Missouri and must be valid for one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of conducting the bid evaluation.

Award of contract will be based on the lowest aggregate sum bid submitted from those bidders that are confirmed as being responsive and responsible. St. Louis County, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids. A responsible bidder is one whose bid complies with the specifications.

Award of contract is contingent upon the Director of Procurement receiving State-funding assistance under the State Aviation Trust Fund and Federal funding assistance under the Airport Improvement Program.

Federal Provisions. This project is subject to the following Federal provisions, statutes and regulations;

Equal Employment Opportunity – Executive Order 11246 and 41 CFR Part 60; The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications" set forth within the supplementary provisions. The successful Bidder shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

Goals for Minority and Female Participation – Executive Order 11246 and 41 CFR Part 60;

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1. The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications" set forth within the supplementary provisions.
2. The goals and timetables for minority and female participation, expressed in percentage terms for the contractor's aggregate workforce in each trade on all construction work in the covered area, are as follows:

Goals for minority participation for each trade: 14.7%

Goals for female participation in each trade: 6.9%

State Wage Requirements. The contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards included in the Supplementary Provisions.

The contractor shall be responsible for determining from the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations if Excessive Unemployment Restrictions are in effect at the time of bidding. This information can be found at the Division of Labor Standards website (<http://www.dolir.mo.gov/ls/index.asp>) and click on the Prevailing Wage Section; or call the Division of Labor Standards at (573) 751-3403.

Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities – 41 CFR Part 60; A certification of Nonsegregated Facilities must be submitted prior to the award of a federally-assisted construction contract exceeding \$10,000 which is not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause.

Contractors receiving federally assisted construction contract awards exceeding \$10,000, which are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause will be required to provide for the forwarding of the notice to prospective subcontractors for supplies and construction contracts where the subcontracts exceed \$10,000 and are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity Clause. The penalty for making false statements in offers is prescribed in 18 U.S.C. 1001.

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise – 49 CFR Part 26; The requirements of 49 CFR Part 26, Regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, apply to this contract. It is the policy of MoDOT and the County to practice nondiscrimination based on race, color, sex or national origin in the award or performance of this contract. All firms qualifying under this solicitation are encouraged to submit bids/proposals. Awards of this contract will be conditioned upon satisfying the requirements of this section. These requirements apply to all bidders, including those who qualify as a DBE. A DBE contract goal of twelve percent (12%) has been established for this contract. The non-DBE bidder shall subcontract twelve percent (12%) of the dollar value of the base bid(s), excluding any additive alternates, to disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE) or make good faith efforts to meet the DBE contract goal. The bidder and any subcontractor, who qualifies as a DBE who subcontracts work to another non-DBE firm, must subtract the amount of the non-DBE contract from the total DBE work counted toward the goal, as defined in 49 CFR Part 26.55.

The apparent successful competitor will be required to submit the following information: (1) the names and addresses of DBE firms that will participate in the contract; (2) a description of the work that each DBE firm will perform; (3) the dollar amount of the participation of each DBE firm participating; (4) written documentation (signed contract proposal) of the bidders commitment to use a DBE subcontractor whose participation it submits to meet the contract goal; and (5) if the contract goal is not met, evidence of good faith efforts, as described in 49 CFR Part 26.

Davis-Bacon Act, as amended – 29 CFR Part 5: The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the current schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor included in the supplementary provisions.

In addition, the contractor will also be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards included in the Supplementary Provisions.

The highest rate between the two (Federal and State) for each job classification shall be considered the prevailing wage.

Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion – 49 CFR Part 29: The bidder certifies, by submission of a proposal or acceptance of a contract, that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any Federal department or agency. Individuals or companies listed in the General Services Administration's "Excluded Parties Listing System" will not be considered for award of contract.

Foreign Trade Restriction – 49 CFR Part 30: The Bidder and Bidder's subcontractors, by submission of an offer and/or execution of a contract, is required to certify that it:

- a. Is not owned or controlled by one or more citizens of a foreign country included in the list of countries that discriminate against U.S. firms published by the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR);
- b. Has not knowingly entered into any contract or subcontract for this project with a person that is a citizen or national of a foreign country on said list, or is owned or controlled directly or indirectly by one or more citizens or nationals of a foreign country on said list;
- c. Has not procured any product nor subcontracted for the supply of any product for use on the project that is produced in a foreign country on said list.

Title VI Solicitation Notice:

The County of St. Louis, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Buy American Certificate – Aviation Safety and Capacity Act of 1990: This contract is subject to the "Buy American Preferences" of the Aviation Safety and Capacity Act of 1990. Prospective Bidders are required to certify that steel and manufactured products have been produced in the United States and to clearly identify those items produced or manufactured outside of the United States.

Airport Job Special Provision: "Notice to all potential bidders on federally funded airport construction projects: As mandated by Executive Order 12818, issued by President George Bush on October 23, 1992, a Job Special Provision will be inserted into and made part of every contract for federally funded airport construction projects, awarded from this or future notices of lettings."

Additional Provisions. Modification to the project documents may only be made by written addendum by the Director of Procurement or Director of Procurement's authorized Representative.

Bid Format. It is the County's preference that all bid prices be submitted electronically on MUNIS Vendor Self Service. If a bidder is unable to bid electronically then the bidder shall supply a written bid per instructions contained in Section 2, Document 00100 Instructions to Bidders, 1.20. All bidders must supply all required information prior to the time of bid opening in either electronic or written form.
