



Franklin, Jefferson Counties Implement Highway Safety Plan

Franklin and Jefferson Counties are one step closer to making zero roadway fatalities a reality.

The two counties have finished implementation of MoDOT's Safety Strategic Highway Plans, which outlines ways to reduce fatalities and serious injury crashes.

In Jefferson County, the plans include:

- Increased enforcement and outreach to target speeding, seatbelt usage and impaired driving.
- Adding edge line pavement markings and rumble strips.
- Removing or marking fixed roadside objects, such as signs and trees.
- Enhancing signage at curves.

In Franklin County, the plans call for:

- Increased enforcement/outreach to target speeders, impaired driving, seatbelt usage, young drivers and distracted drivers.
- Adding edge line pavement marking and rumble strips.
- Increasing sight distance along road and at intersections.
- Removing or marking fixed roadside objects, such as signs and trees.

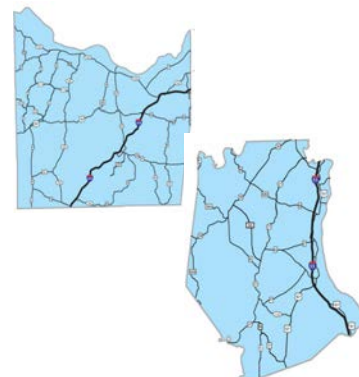
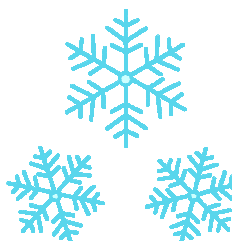

Winter is almost here and that means it is time for our trucks to hit the road. In fact, many of them will be out on November 4 for a "dry run" of our winter routes. Here's just a few stats about last winter in the St. Louis District:

- 16 winter events totaling 16.8 inches
- 24,500 tons of salt used
- 114,000 gallons of beet juice used
- 12,800 pounds of calcium chloride
- 93,945 hours worked
