



Route M Landslide Repairs to be Completed by November

Route M in Jefferson County will be open by November 1. Bids to repair the slide on the section of Route M between I-55 and Route 61/67 will be opened on August 18 and once the project is awarded the contractor has until November 1 to repair the slide.

This repair was challenging and was not an easy fix. MoDOT had to acquire right of way from three land owners, have numerous utilities relocated and get all environmental clearances. The process is moving as fast as possible.

With school starting this month, MoDOT will continue to monitor traffic flow on Imperial/Main Street, especially during school rush hours. We will make adjustments to the signals as needed.

I know it has been an inconvenience for many of you that Route M remains closed but I can not stress enough the dangers of this slide. I want to thank you all for your patience during this time.

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Safety Project Makes Improvements in Franklin County

Over the last 10 years, 8,752 Missourians have died in car crashes. They, along with the other 30,000 motorists who die on the road every year, are the faces of a troubling statistic. MoDOT's newest design-build project takes direct aim at that statistic.

This one-of-a-kind project will improve safety around Franklin County by tapping into public and private industries to find innovative strategies to reduce crashes and save lives.

The St. Louis District Safety Design-Build project will make safety improvements at 31 locations in Franklin and St. Charles Counties. Among the improvements being made in Franklin County:

- Rumble strips along stretches of Route 30, Route 100 and Route NN
- Stop ahead pavement markings on Route HH at Finney Road and Route 30

Over 10 years, the improvements are expected to reduce the number of fatal and serious injury crashes by more than 70 people.

The project, which got underway in July, is expected to be completed by the winter of 2018.
