Mid Rivers/I-70 Interchange Construction Coming *Public Meeting on Traffic Impacts on January 31*

The Interstate 70 and Mid Rivers Mall Drive interchange is about to undergo a major facelift. The interchange will be transformed into a diverging diamond interchange, similar to the new I-270 and Dorsett interchange in Maryland Heights. The new design will improve traffic flow on and off I-70 and on Mid Rivers Mall Drive.

Construction will begin in March with completion scheduled by November 1. There will be impacts to traffic including lane closures on I-70 and some periods when ramps at the interchange are closed. Detailed information on the construction impacts will be available at a public meeting from 4-7 p.m. Thursday, January 31 at the St. Peters City Hall. Maps showing the stages of construction impacts and drawings showing how the new interchange will work will be available at the open house meeting. The displays will also be posted online at www.modot.org/stlouis.

The main detour during construction will be to use the new Salt River Road, which connects Route 370 to Route 79. Salt River Road has an intersection with Mid Rivers Mall Drive and will serve as an easy way to get to and from the major highways and the mall while various ramps at the I-70 and the Mid Rivers Mall Drive interchange are closed.
