## Right Lane Westbound I-70 at 79 Closed 3 Months

Construction is underway to convert the existing Interstate 70 and Mid Rivers Mall Drive interchange from a cloverleaf into a new diverging diamond. This construction project includes some work on the I-70 bridges over Dardenne Creek, located between Mid Rivers Mall Drive and Route 79. Beginning Monday, April 22, the right lane will be closed over Dardenne Creek for three months. The closure will affect the exit only lane to Route 79. Motorists will still be able to exit to Route 79, but they will not have a dedicated lane from Mid Rivers Mall Drive to Route 79. Construction on the overall interchange project will be complete in Fall 2013.
