## I-64 Boone Bridge Construction In the River

Construction for the new I-64 Daniel Boone Missouri River Bridge has been underway since January. Crews are actively working on the 12 sets of columns that will support the new bridge. By the end of the year, you should be able to see all of the foundations coming up out of the water or on the land. Crews also continue to work on the new ramp from Chesterfield Airport Road to westbound I-64 and the connection of the North Outer Road to westbound I-64. ## I-70/Mid Rivers Mall Dr to Open in November

The work zone at the I-70 and Mid Rivers Mall Drive interchange continues to have lane closures on I-70 and ramp closures for Mid Rivers. We are on schedule to open the interchange and the lanes on I-70 by mid November, weather permitting.

Only three lanes are open on I-70 at the moment but a fourth lane should be reopening sometime in October. We appreciate your patience as we complete the transformation of the interchange.

## Traffic Changes on Route 364 Phase 3 In October

The Route 364 Page Phase 3 project will involve some traffic pattern changes in October.

- Monday, October 14, Old Gutermuth Road will no longer be a through street. The road will service all properties on the north and south sides of the new Route 364, but it will be dead ended on either side of state property. Motorists can use Gutermuth Road as the through street.
- Route N at Stump Road connecting to South Outer 364 will be closed for a short closure at the end of October. Crews are finishing the construction of Route N connecting to Bryan Road, which will open November 1. Exact dates and detour information for the closure should be announced in the next week.
