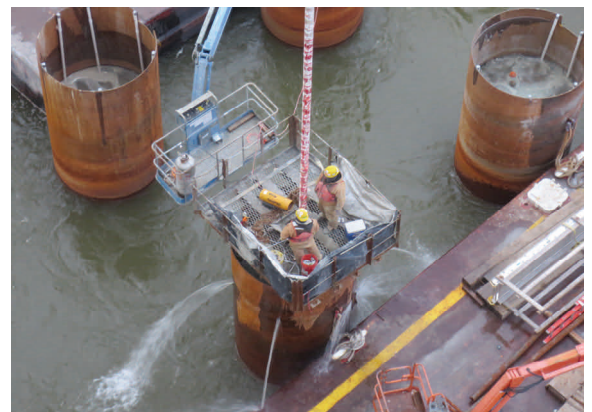

## 2014 Look Ahead

1. **The Interstate 64 Daniel Boone Missouri River Bridge** construction work continues in 2014. Crews have completed the drilling work for the new bridge foundations and are now pouring concrete into the shafts. In addition to the new bridge, motorists can expect a new North Outer Road and Chesterfield Airport Road interchange by November. The new eastbound bridge will open in late 2014, with full project completion at the end of 2015.
2. **The Route 364 Page Phase 3** project also continues throughout 2014. Crews are working to build bridges over Motherhead Road and Henke Road. The new section of roadway between I-64 and Route K is expected to open in Fall of 2014, with the section between Route K and Route 94 opening a few weeks later.
3. **Shoulder Widening and Resurfacing Work** continues on Routes D and DD. That project is expected to be complete this summer. Crews will begin similar work on Route N west of I-64 this spring.
4. **Resurfacing work on I-64 from Route DD to Lake St. Louis** is expected to begin in May with completion of the project by the end of the year.
5. **Route 94 and Terry Road Improvement** plans are moving forward. A public meeting was held earlier this month to outline plans to raise that section of Route 94 to lessen the impact flood waters have on the area. That project is scheduled for construction in 2015.
