## MoDOT Snow Removal Crews Have Busy Winter

Crews with the Missouri Department of Transportation are having an extra busy winter due to the large amount of snowfall and extreme cold temperatures that hit the region.

To date, here are just a few figures about MoDOT's snow removal operations on state roads in St. Charles County.

- St. Charles MoDOT crews spent nearly 8,000 hours this winter on snow and ice removal efforts.
- More than 100,000 miles were put on MoDOT plows and salt trucks in the St. Charles area.
- Nearly 4,500 tons of salt was used.
- Nearly 780 tons of sand was put down on area roads.
- Crews spread more than 16,000 pounds of dry pellet calcium chloride.
- More than 8,500 gallons of liquid calcium chloride was used.
- More than 10,000 gallons of Geomelt/beet juice was used.
- More than 51,000 gallons of salt brine was used.
