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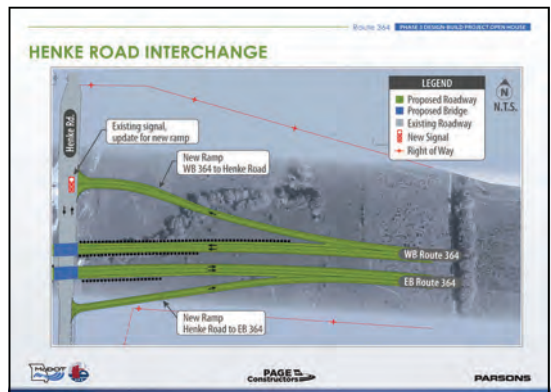

Closure of Henke Road Connection to Route N and I-64

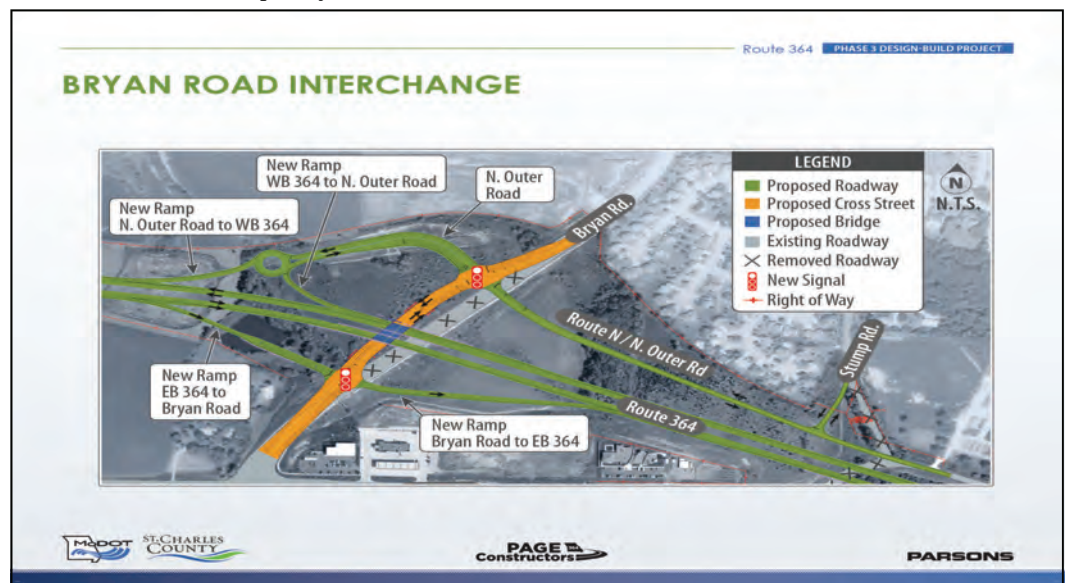
MoDOT is closing the connection between Henke Road/Technology Drive and Interstate 64 on Monday, April 28. Motorists will no longer be able to access Route N and I-64 from Henke Road. Old Highway N or Ronald Reagan Drive should be used to cross I-64 to get to Route N to the west or the I-64 ramps. Although this connection will never reopen, Henke Road will eventually tie into the new Route 364.

Redesign Of Bryan Road Interchange and Schedule Change

Route 364 is a design-build project, which means the design of the road is happening at the same time as construction. As design moved forward, MoDOT determined a change was necessary to provide access to a property owner off Bryan Road. To do that, we changed the westbound Route 364 exit to Bryan Road from a folded diamond interchange to a roundabout which should help overall traffic flow. The change means the new road will now open in two phases instead of three. Route 364 will open from I-64 to Route K on October 3 with the entire stretch of the new road still scheduled to open by October 31, 2014.
