## Second Half of Route 364 Opening to Traffic Soon

The second half of the new Route 364/Page Phase 3 from Route K to Route 94/Mid Rivers Mall Drive will be open to traffic the weekend of October 31.

Once the mainline lanes open, crews will still need to complete work at the connection of Route 364/Page Phase 3 and existing stretch of Route 364/Route 94. That means there will be some ramps in that area that will not open the weekend of October 31. One of those ramps will be the ramp from eastbound Route 364 to westbound Route 94 and Mid Rivers Mall Drive.
